Dr. Bill Lydiatt is a nationally recognized surgeon, healthcare executive, educator, and advocate whose career has been defined by innovation in patient care, leadership, and medical education. He currently serves as CEO of Clarkson Institute.

Dr. Lydiatt earned his Bachelor of Science degree from Stanford University and his Doctor of Medicine from the University of Nebraska Medical Center, where he also completed his residency in Otolaryngology–Head and Neck Surgery. He later completed a fellowship in Head and Neck Surgical Oncology at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in New York City. In addition to his medical training, he earned an Executive MBA from the University of Colorado.

Throughout his distinguished career, Dr. Lydiatt has held numerous leadership roles, including Chief Medical Officer, Vice President of Medical Affairs, Vice President of Surgical Services, Chair of Surgery at Nebraska Methodist Hospital and Past President of the American Head and Neck Association. He has dedicated much of his career to improving access to healthcare, with a particular focus on behavioral health, perinatal care, and the prevention of depression among head and neck cancer patients.

A respected voice in medicine and healthcare leadership, Dr. Lydiatt has authored more than 150 publications, books, and book chapters. He is passionate about the intersection of medicine and the arts, exploring how creativity and storytelling can enhance teaching, communication, and patient decision-making.
